Preserving Property in Hancock County

Last fall, the trustees of the CZHF reviewed the proposal from Rev. Felton G. Poole, the pastor of Springfield Baptist Church, regarding the plan to locate, identify, and restore historical structures on the Hancock County property owned by the foundation. The proposal also was discussed with Dr. Clinton Warner and Dr. Willis Hubert specifically in relation to the Log Cabin owned by the Association for the Advancement of Negro Country Life. Both gentlemen granted their permission to include that building in the first phase of the project. Dr. Warner also agreed that his property (the store and the Piney Rest property) should be included.

In other developments, the board of commissioners in Hancock County has been studying the feasibility of developing a recreational facility on the Piney Rest property.
